Policy on Encounter Church Tuition Scholarships to Central Kansas Christian Academy

It is the practice of Encounter Church to set aside funds in the annual budget earmarked for tuition scholarships for students attending Central Kansas Christian Academy (CKCA). At the discretion of the Board, budget surplus may also be utilized if the requests for scholarships exceed the budgeted amount.

Eligibility Requirements & Expectations:

- As funds are available, Encounter Church will provide tuition scholarships to CKCA for children of those families who actively attend (50% attendance threshold) Encounter Church. The scholarship amount will be determined in April or May of each year by the Church Deacon Board, and will be available for use in the following school year only. Requests for scholarships from those families who do not actively attend Encounter Church will not receive priority and will only be taken into consideration on a case-by-case basis if any remaining funds are available.
- Any child receiving scholarship funds from Encounter Church will be expected to keep their account with the school current and be in good standing overall. If there is an outstanding balance on tuition at the end of the current school year [as of June 30th], the child will be ineligible to receive scholarship funds from Encounter Church until said balance is paid in full, unless prior arrangements have been made with the school.
- We further encourage the parents of all children receiving Encounter Church scholarship funds to be proactively supportive of the school by looking
 for ways to assist and provide volunteer service and assistance in areas of the school where needed. Parents are also expected to actively
 demonstrate support for the school by participating in school activities and functions in every way possible.
