Dear parents,  
Reading aloud to your child can be one of the best parenting experiences! We hope you and your child create many loving memories as you explore books together. Reading at least 20 minutes a day with your child will enhance their fine motor skills, create a strong vocabulary, teach empathy, along with many other benefits. The CKCA school library has books that have been deemed appropriate for our students with several having good biblical values. In our library we will discuss and demonstrate appropriate library responsibilities and expectations. Please review this contract with your child that both you and your child agree with the terms. Your child may only borrow books once this contract is signed and returned.

Library responsibilities/expectations include:

- Being respectful, responsible, and cooperative.
- Always walking in the library.
- Entering and exiting the library quietly.
- Returning books on time, and in the same condition as when checked out.
- Taking great care of books.
- Keeping food and drinks away from books.
- Keeping books away from pets.
- Using a bookmark while reading. Avoid folding corners.
- Not writing or coloring in books.
- Always having clean hands while using books.
- Keeping books away from water.

If student/child receives an overdue notice, it's just a reminder that the books need to be returned. If student/child has an overdue book they may not check out another one until all overdue books are returned. If a book becomes lost or is damaged beyond repair, the student/child is responsible for paying for the book or replacing it with the exact same book.
